Gift to Governor's Library

The North Carolina Library Association presented to Governor Terry Sanford a collection of reference books for the Mansion Library. Carlton P. West, President of the Library Association, made the official presentation in the presence of a special committee, including the associate director of National Library Week in North Carolina.

The brief ceremony took place in the Governor's office. The addition of these books will enlarge the collection of North Carolina material which has been gathered by the North Carolina Writers Conference and some individuals, all of whom are interested in having a permanent library for the Mansion.

Governor Sanford expressed surprise when he moved to the Mansion and realized that each governor had been bringing his own private library for use. The purpose of this library is to provide information about North Carolina and representative literature of the state as well as a working library for the Governor and his family.

Future visitors to the Mansion will notice that the general North Carolina collection is housed in the library on first floor and most of the reference materials are in the Governor's study.

In accepting the books, the Governor recognized the great need for books and libraries in easy access of all our citizens. He commended librarians and citizens for their effort in providing good library service and expressed keen appreciation for the attention given to developing a permanent library for the Governor's Mansion in North Carolina.

New North Carolina Books

By William S. Powell

Richard Walser, editor. The Poems of Governor Thomas Burke of North Carolina. Raleigh: State Department of Archives and History, 1961. 69 pp. \$3.00.

Thomas Burke, governor of North Carolina in 1781 and 1782, has the distinction of having been captured by the Tories during the Revolution. As a strong advocate of states' rights while serving in the Continental Congress he opposed the Articles of Confederation. Earlier he had served as a member of a committee appointed to prepare a temporary civil government and draft a constitution for the new State of North Carolina. The contributions and the tribulations of Thomas Burke are all set forth in Professor Walser's introduction and notes. The type and format are designed to give the modern reader a close approximation of a book which might have been published in the eighteenth century. It is, indeed, a handsome work of typographical art.

Burke's poems have survived in manuscript or in contemporary newspapers and of them the editor says they "ring with the sincerity of one whose heart was ever on display."

Warren B. Smith. White Servitude in Colonial South Carolina. Columbia: University of South Carolina Press, 1961. 141 pp. \$4.75.

While this study is devoted to South Carolina it does cover in part the period of time when the two Carolinas were a single colony, and many of the sources as well as some of the conclusions may also be applied to North Carolina. The subject is one not

adequately covered for North Carolina even in Abbot E. Smith's *Colonists in Bondage*. This is a subject which will appeal to the student of early American history, and in this book it is well organized and adequately indexed so that its use is enhanced for the researcher and genealogist.

Robert F. Cope and Manly Wade Wellman. The County of Gaston. Gastonia: Gaston County Historical Society, 1961. 274 pp. \$7.50.

The latest volume of county history to come from the typewriter of Chapel Hill author Manly Wade Wellman is *The County of Gaston* which he prepared with the collaboration of Robert F. Cope. Two years ago he published *The County of Warren*.

County histories often are not worth much more than the paper they are printed on except to the descendants of the soldiers listed in the appendix. Manly Wellman, however, has hit upon a new formula which changes the picture. He is currently working on a history of Moore County and reports that he plans to do several more before his enthusiasm wanes.

Instead of following the old cut and dried pattern of a hodge-podge arranged in chronological order, or a war-to-war account, or a chapter on schools, another on churches, Mr. Wellman has combined the secrets of the historian with the arts of the novelist, losing none of the advantages of either, to produce a readable county history. For the various chronological periods into which the history of a county naturally divides itself, he has selected a dramatic event. He tells what happened to lead up to that event and what its consequences were. At the same time he very skillfully weaves into the story bits of information about progress in other areas.

In one brief section we find a bit of geography, something about agriculture, the domestic occupations of women, the work of men, the shortage of doctors, how children were taught, and a suggestion of the esteem with which preachers were regarded. And it is all quite readable.

When you have finished reading one of Manly Wellman's county histories you not only have the basic historical facts but you have sensed something of the feeling or atmosphere of the county. His story of Warren suggests the ancient, aristocratic, sleepy county; in this Gaston history we get the feeling of a modern, industrial community.

Histories like these deserve to be in every library in this state. They should be read by local historians, and librarians should urge them to go and try to follow these examples.

Howard Murry. Salt o' Life. Winston-Salem: John F. Blair, Publisher, 1961. 147 pp. \$3.25.

Howard Murry is an artist who has retired to a mountain community in Watauga County. These bits of Tar Heel humor which he has collected from his neighbors will delight a wide variety of readers. There are more than three dozen short pieces which reveal

many sides of the character of the mountaineer and the summer guest in the region. Each is a gem of the art of story telling and the punch line is sharp and clear. The response will range from a big grin to a deep guffaw, but they're all sure to please. The author's own paintings are used to illustrate this book.

Helen Bevington. When Found, Make a Verse Of. New York: Simon and Schuster, 1961. 314 pp. \$4.30.

For a delightful evening's entertainment *When Found*, by Duke University English professor Helen Bevington, can be recommended without hesitation. It consists of choice paragraphs, sentences, and poems which she has collected from her wide reading. Many of them have inspired poems of her own which are here. Much of the book concerns famous people she has known, noted writers of the past, and places she has visited. There is also something of modern North Carolina as viewed through the poet's eye. "The Bird Watcher" will make a choice bit to remember and tell at just the right party.

Duane Meyer. The Highland Scots of North Carolina, 1732–1776. Chapel Hill: University of North Carolina Press, 1961. 218 pp. \$6.00.

This careful study of the Highland Scots who settled along the upper Cape Fear River in the eighteenth century will prove to be fascinating to the North Carolinian interested in the origins of the people of the state. Records in Great Britain as well as in North Carolina have been combed to produce facts never before brought to light by the more general historians. The causes of migration and the question of Loyalism among the Scots during the Revolution are seen in a new perspective. Much detail—names of individuals and families, exact references to places of origin in Scotland and settlement here, comments on general and specific problems facing the new settlers—will suggest the care with which this study has been made.

Lucy Daniels. High on a Hill. New York: McGraw-Hill, 1961. 320 pp. \$4.95.

Miss Daniels, a native of Raleigh, has written a novel on a subject which will be unfamiliar to many readers. This fact alone should make it attractive to those who read, not for entertainment alone, but to expand their own field of knowledge. The story deals with patients and doctors at Holly Springs Hospital for Nervous and Mental Disorders. A sensitive writer, Miss Daniels develops her characters with skill. Her sympathy for them and her understanding of the problems faced by the doctors and the patients produce a novel which will surely hold the reader's interest.

George Bruner Parks. Richard Hakluyt and The English Voyages. New York: Frederick Ungar Publishing Co., 1961. 288 pp. \$9.50.

First published in 1928, this new edition has a few textual changes but the nearly fifty pages of appendices have been thoroughly reorganized and brought up to date. This study of English explorations and settlement as studied and publicized by Richard

Hakluyt in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries will be a basic source for anyone interested in the first attempts to colonize North Carolina. References will be found throughout the book to Sir Walter Raleigh and the Virginia colony. In addition to its usefulness as a study of early geography, the list of Hakluyt's own writings and the list of English books on geography and travel to 1600 will prove a boon to the librarian. Numerous illustrations are from contemporary prints of Hakluyt's contemporaries and reproductions of maps of the time.

LeGette Blythe and Charles R. Brockmann. Hornets' Nest, The Story of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County. Charlotte: Public Library of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County, 1961. 511 pp. \$7.50.

To this massive illustrated history of Mecklenburg, LeGette Blythe contributes a narrative account in 155 pages. The remainder is a picture as told "topically" by Mr. Brockmann. This appears to be a new departure for a book of this type and it meets admirably the needs of several types of user. The newcomer or the person only recently become aware of local history will find Mr. Blythe's account a readable one; the subject is adequately covered both as to time and subject. Out of 155 pages in this section, few North Carolinians will be surprised to find that 38 are devoted in whole or in part to the controversial Mecklenburg Declaration of Independence. If the reader accepts Mr. Blythe's account, another fan will have been added to the club. Mr. Brockmann's topical account will appeal not only to the browsing reader but also to the researcher. His topics range from "Automobiles in Charlotte" to "Zonta Club," and in time from 1670 to 1960. The Charlotte Public Library is to be commended for its role in the production of this splendid volume. An act of the General Assembly amended the Library's charter to make possible its cooperation with the Chamber of Commerce in this venture.

Denis Meadows. Five Remarkable Englishmen. New York: The Devin-Adair Company, 1961. 245 pp. \$5.00.

This new look at five men who played important roles in the colonial history of America will provide food for thought to those who might like to take their own new look at other early American heroes. Discussed here are Sir Walter Raleigh (as he spelled his name), Captain John Smith, John Winthrop, William Penn, and James Oglethorpe. They are seen in the light of their times and presented as "new men" of England who rose to power from backgrounds not previously expected to produce leaders. Raleigh and Smith, for example, were farm boys who became military heroes and great explorers.

Sallie F. Hill. The Progressive Farmer's Southern Cookbook. New York: G. P. Putnam's Sons, 1961. 469 pp. \$4.95.

Miss Hill, long-time editor of the Home Department of The Progressive Farmer, has compiled some real sure enough Southern recipes, the kind that will be helpful to the bride and the matron as well. She tells how to prepare a 'possum for cooking and then how to roast him; there're directions for poke greens and crackling bread; and on the other hand, recipes for roast pheasant, apple fritters, coconut cake, tomato aspic, corn

on the cob, banana-nut bread, and so on down the table. There are definitions, hints and measures, foods named for Southern heroes, oldtime foods, menus, and hints on meal planning.

Edmund Ruffin. An Essay on Calcareous Manures. Edited by J. Carlyle Sitterson. Cambridge, Mass.: Harvard University Press, 1961. 199 pp. \$4.25.

Dean Sitterson of the University of North Carolina gives us a very interesting essay on "Edmund Ruffin, Agricultural Reformer and Southern Radical." By way of preface to Ruffin's book, first published in 1832, we learn that he initiated an era of agricultural reform in the Old South by advocating the use of "calcareous manures"—substances such as marl which contain calcium carbonate. Ruffin's book is more than a curiosity; it will prove fascinating for modern readers whose interests are in the fields of geography or geology, history, farming, or, perhaps, gardening. Reports of Ruffin's experiments will provide the reader with bits of information which he might find useful to amaze his friends. For example, "A mule eats less corn than a horse, but more hay, and lives longer."

William H. Cartwright and Richard L. Watson, Jr., co-editors. Interpreting and Teaching American History. Washington: National Council for the Social Studies, 1961. 430 pp. \$4.00 pa. \$5.00 cl.

The co-editors, members of the Duke University faculty, have assembled two dozen essays, largely bibliographical in nature, on the various periods and aspects of American history. Seven of the authors are Tar Heels and others have connections with our state. There is much here on the various schools of interpretation of American history, and the volumes illustrating them are cited in full. There are critical notes on special studies and numerous series of books, periodicals in specialized areas, and books in related fields are discussed. This book will make a good book selection tool for the librarian and should serve as a starting point for anyone making a study in a particular period of American history.

Hal Bridges. Lee's Maverick General, Daniel Harvey Hill. New York: McGraw-Hill Book Company, 1961. 323 pp. \$7.50.

Any Civil War fan will thank his librarian heartily for directing him to this detailed study of General Hill's wartime career. It is not a complete biography of Hill although there are facts about his early life; it deals almost entirely with the war years and is interpretive as well as factual. By way of prologue, author Bridges tells us the questions which have long existed concerning Hill's role in certain debated situations. Among them, his attitude towards General Lee, his relationship with General Bragg, whether he was responsible for the "Lost Dispatch," and his part in the famous generals' petition to President Davis for the removal of Bragg from command of the Army of Tennessee. This book contains possible answers to these and other questions about Hill and his associates.
